This year there are Board of Trustee elections around the country. Below is the time frame that our school will be following for the elections:

Select Returning Officer - Wednesday 1 May

Close Main Roll - Noon Wednesday 8 May

Call for Nomination by - Friday 10 May

Close Supplementary Roll - Noon Wednesday 22 May

Nominations Close - Noon Friday 24 May
Voting Papers Sent by - Wednesday 29 May
Election Day (voting closes) - **Noon Friday 7 June**Count Votes - Thursday 13 June

Note: there is no election unless there are more people standing than there are places on the Board of Trustees. The St Pius X Board of Trustees has always set the number of elected parent representatives at 5. If anyone is interested in finding out more about the Board of Trustees they are welcome to contact the Principal for further information.
