Message from Waikato District Health Board.—Measles

Measles can be dangerous for children and adults. Please get your children vaccinated at 12 months and 4 years old to prevent measles. It's free at the doctors. If you or your child has not had a measles vaccine, please see your doctor. The symptoms of measles are a fever, runny nose, cough, red eyes, then a rash. You can spread measles to others from five days before, until five days after, the rash appears.


