Returning to School in Level 2

Now that we will be in Level 2 tomorrow, arrangements have changed. Classes will resume as normal. Children will not be required to wear masks in Years 4 to 8 unless they want to. Playtimes and lunchtimes will return to normal as well as pick up which will be at 2:45pm for all students.

The following health measures will still be in place

- Parents <u>are not</u> to come on to the school site during drop-offs and pick-ups.
- Parents should wear face coverings when dropping off and picking up students from school and remain distanced from the school as much as possible.
- Visitors, including parents and caregivers, should maintain a two-metre distance from those who are not part of their household bubble.
- All visitors and parents who need to come to the office will be admitted to reception on a case by case basis.
- Children will be encouraged to practise good hygiene habits and sanitiser will be available in all classrooms.
- Any child displaying symptoms will need to be picked up immediately.
- Cleaning: All surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected daily.
- We will not be holding our usual assemblies, prize-giving or performances. These will take on alternative formats that are appropriate to each occasion.

Outdoor Education and Camp will not go ahead however, some alternative outdoor activities will be planned for the end of the year. Teachers will be in touch later regarding details.

Children are to be in summer uniform when they return to school and sun hats are compulsory for playing outside.

We look forward to welcoming our students back tomorrow.
