WAIKATO COMMUNITY SCHOOL OF MUSIC TE KURA WAIATA O TE HAPORI O WAIKATO

Saturday morning music classes

Enrolments are now open for Term Two 2022 at the Waikato Community School of Music. The first session is on <u>Saturday 7th May</u>. The school caters for all ages (3 to retired) and ability levels, offering group-format and one-toone music tuition in a range of instruments. Group-format class fees range from \$45 to \$110 per term (7 lessons in Term Two) depending on student age and the instrument chosen. The enrolment fee for an instrument class includes participation in as many of our ensembles as the student wishes. Enrolment in ensembles only is also an option. One -to-one classes can aid in preparing for exams and earning NCEA credits.

Class times are between 8:00am and 2:00pm on Saturdays during primary school terms. WCSM is located on the University of Waikato campus in Hillcrest. (Note that all those aged 12 or over on University premises must be vaccinated, including students, parents, caregivers and tutors. Those age 8 or over should wear a mask).

PLEASE NOTE that all of our classes are held in University of Waikato classrooms. The

University has mandated that anyone in its buildings who is eligible for a Covid-19 vaccination, and who does not hold an exemption, must be fully vaccinated. This applies to tutors, students, parents and caregivers. Be aware that WCSM staff may ask for evidence of vaccination status.
