Healthy Lunchbox Idea

Soft cheese & salad sandwich recipe 2 thick slices of wholemeal bread 2 tablespoons medium-fat soft cheese 3cm piece of cucumber, finely chopped 20g celery (about two-thirds of a stick), finely chopped Small wedge of lettuce, to give 2 tbs when shredded Pinch of black pepper or paprika (optional)

Spread both slices of bread with the cheese

Spreading the cheese on both slices of the bread and patting the salad dry helps prevent a soggy sandwich!

Pat the salad dry and use to fill the sandwich, sprinkling with pepper or paprika if using.

**Try other salad vegetables, or even some pineapple.

Complete the lunchbox with:

Bottle of water

Piece of fruit

Healthy muesli bar


